- **Scheduling Software:** identifies milestones and critical path. Integrated with displays in production and test departments to provide a high degree of visibility for all parties involved in each project. Also integrated with Revere's extranet (REX) to allow customers to view schedules, too.
- **Budget Controls:** software provides red flags when parameters exceed specified thresholds. Monthly

reviews help identify items that need to be addressed before they become problems.

- **Organization:** standardized file structure supports operational consistency and facilitates information sharing via REX.
- **Software Development:** established standards and software reuse contribute to efficiency and consistency. Software automation speeds generation of CAD drawings, contributing to efficiency.
- **Installation/Commissioning:** active involvement in coordination meetings assures timely installation. Acceptance testing and startup procedures address final punch list completion.
